

♪♪ *Two little feet go tap, tap, tap,...* ♪♪

Baby Annabell has quite small feet. Do you have any doll shoes that are too big for her? No problem. There is an easy way to create some DIY insoles to make them fit.

WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- print out (see page 2)
- thick felt (4 mm is ideal)
- pencil
- scissors

And a printer - black and white is fine.



Cut the soles out of the print out (see page 2).



Place the paper soles on a piece of felt and draw an outline with the pencil.



Remove the paper soles and carefully cut the felt with the scissors along the outlines.



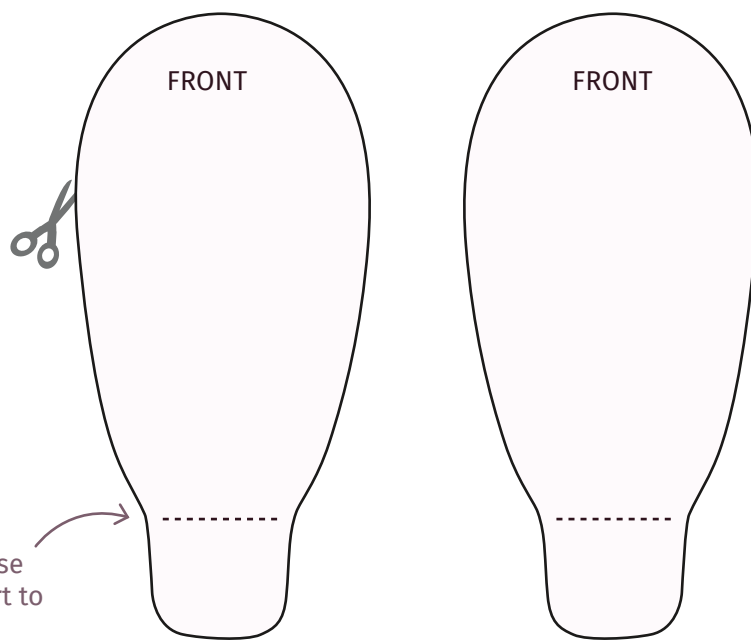
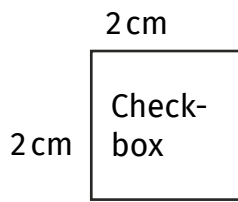
Insert the felt soles into the doll shoes that you have.



Bend the back end of the felt soles upwards at the heel of the shoe. Use this excess part for easy handling.



The soles should now fit perfectly! With these customized shoes Baby Annabell can finally start playing.



Fold here to use the excess part to grip the soles.

Cut out the template along the solid line.
Once you have printed this sheet out, measure the checkbox using a ruler. If it is 2 cm wide, you have the correct size of the insoles on your print out.
