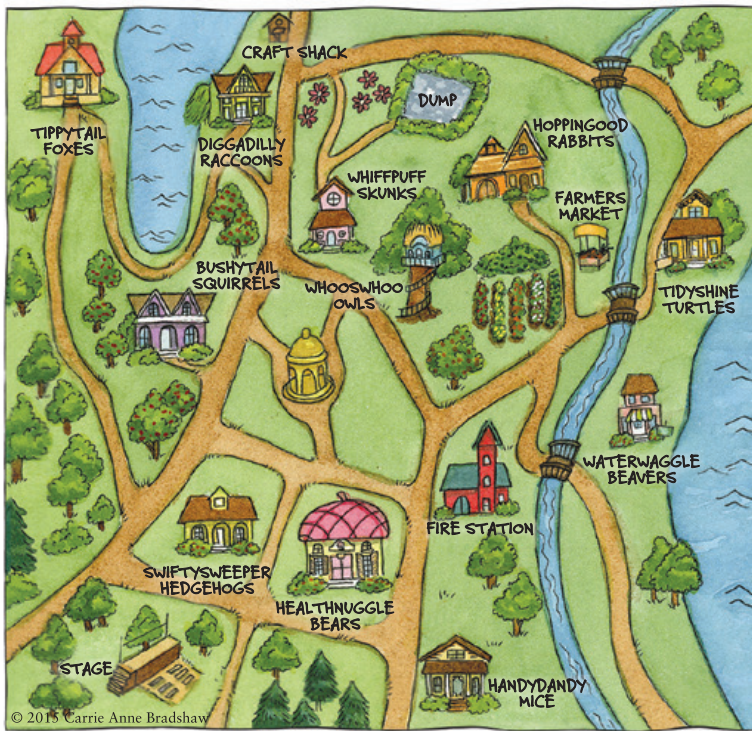

finished Mina.






“Don’t worry,” said their
